



The National Stone Centre is pleased to host Butterfly Conservation East Midlands for a Big Butterfly Count on **Sunday 25th July 2021**. This is part of a UK-wide survey and is a fun free citizen science event aimed at engaging children and adults with the natural world while helping to assess the health of our local environment.

Experts will be on hand from **11am to 4pm** to provide information, answer questions and help with butterfly identification, and a Butterfly Conservation Derbyshire Recorder will be present to record sightings made by visitors around our beautiful site of mixed woodland and meadow.
